Popular science presentation

Popular science presentation (Norwegian)

Konferansen og sommerskolen for Society of Experimental Finance (SFE) vil finne sted i Stavanger i juni 2024. For første gang vil arrangementet inkludere en utvidet nettverksøkt med søkelys på kvinner i finans. Målet med dette initiativet er å gi mentorstøtte for unge kvinnelige forskere og en mulighet for nettverksbygging for kvinner som forsker og kvinner som jobber innenfor finansområdet.

Vi vil arrangere en paneldebatt der sentrale kvinnelige forskere i finans kan dele sine erfaringer, diskutere utfordringer de har møtt eller møter, og hvordan de har overkommet dem. På samme samling vil kvinnelige næringslivsledere med bakgrunn og interesse for finans fra finansgruppen i Næringsforeningen i Rogaland delta. Tanken er at å koble den teoretiske tilnærmingen innenfor finans med den praktiske tilnærmingen og erfaringer. Vi mener at dette er et svært viktig initiativ og kunne være til stor inspirasjon for deltakerne, siden det er nesten 60% frafall for kvinnelig forskere i finans på veien til professorkompetanse.

Sommer-skole-delen av arrangementet er rettet mot 30 doktorgradsstudenter, masterstudenter og andre som er på et tidlig stadium i sin forskningskarriere og som ønsker å lære mer om fremskrittene innen eksperimentell finans og selskapsstyring.

Konferansen sentrerer rundt diskusjon og formidling av forskningsartikler som søker å forstå ulike problemsstillinger rundt funksjonen og etikken i finansmarkedene.

Popular science presentation - Updated (Norwegian)

Konferansen og sommerskolen for Society of Experimental Finance ble arrangert på Universitetet i Stavanger i juni 2024. For første gang inkluderte arrangementet en nettverkssamling med fokus på kvinner i finans. Målet med dette initiativet var å tilby mentorordning for unge kvinnelige forskere, samt skape en møteplass for kvinnene i finans i regionen.

Under arrangementet var det et panel som inkluderte internasjonale seniorforskere og regionale næringslivsledere fra selskaper som HitecVision, DSD og Herfo Finans, hvor paneldeltakerne delte sine erfaringer, diskuterte barrierer de har møtt og/eller møter, og hvordan de har overvunnet dem. Det var en aktiv utveksling av ideer mellom panelet og deltakerne. Vi mener at dette var et veldig viktig initiativ, siden frafallet fra førsteamanuensis til professorer for kvinner i finans er nesten 60%.

Konferansen vår hadde også kun kvinnelige hovedtalere, noe som er sjeldent innen dette feltet. Videre var hovedtalerne fra ikkeeksperimentelle felt, med mål om å danne bedre forbindelser mellom tradisjonelle finansmetoder og den eksperimentelle tilnærmingen. Denne tverrfaglige tilnærmingen er avgjørende for å øke vår forståelse av finansmarkedene.

Popular science presentation (English)

The Conference and Summer School for the Society of Experimental Finance will take place in Stavanger in June 2024. For the first time, the event will include a networking session with a focus on women in finance. The goal of this initiative is to provide mentoring access for young female researchers, and a networking opportunity for all women who are party of the society. We plan to hold a panel, where senior researchers can share their experiences, discuss barriers they have faced and/or are facing, and how they have overcome them. There will also be a chance to ask questions. We believe this is a very important initiative, since the pipeline from assistant to full professors for women in finance has almost 60% attrition.

The summer school segment of the event is targeted toward 30 Ph.D. students, master students, and early career researchers who want to learn more about the advances in the field of experimental finance, and corporate governance. The conference centers in the discussion and dissemination of research papers that seek to help us understand the function and ethics of financial markets.

Popular science presentation - Updated (English)

The Conference and Summer School for the Society of Experimental Finance took place in Stavanger in June 2024. For the first time, the event included a networking session with a focus on women in finance. The goal of this initiative was to provide

mentoring for young female researchers, and a networking opportunity for all women who are part of the society. In the event, there was a panel, which included senior researchers and local/regional business leaders (from HitecVision, DSD and Herfo Finans), where panelists shared their experiences, discussed barriers they have faced and/or are facing, and how they had overcome them. There was an active exchange of ideas between the panel and the attendees. We believe that this was a very important initiative, since the pipeline from assistant to full professors for women in finance has almost 60% attrition.

Our conference also featured only female keynote speakers, which is a rarity in the field. Furthermore, the keynote speakers were from non-experimental fields, with the goal of forming better links between traditional finance methods and the experimental approach. This somewhat interdisciplinary approach is instrumental in increasing our understanding of the financial markets.
