#### Comment

Summary of the actual expenses, all RCN funded:

- Accommodation: 30.964 (Budget: 67.200)
- Travel: 63.170 (Budget: 88.000)
- Food and hospitality: 100.831 (Budget: 91.200)
- Gifts: 714 (Not budgeted)

Total RCN funded costs: 195.679.

Own financing from BI:

- Hours spent on the planning and execution of the conference: 157.050
- Rooms and venues: 60.800

The total RCN funded costs were budgeted at 246.400. The final RCN funded costs were 50.721 lower than budgeted. The deviation is primarily due to low costs on accommodation and travel.

### Impacts and effects

#### Anticipated outcomes and impacts - from the grant application form

The aim of the conference is to increase the quality of accounting research in the Nordic countries. By continuing to organize a high-quality conference, we are able to increase the quantity and quality of accounting research in the Nordic region, partly because we contribute to increase the quality of the PhD students and partly because we make Norway, and BI in particular, visible. We are very pleased to report that increased visibility through the conference (which has been sponsored by Finansmarkedsfondet and BI or only BI) and investments made by BI has enabled BI to hire two professors, one associate professor, and five assistant professors the last six years.

The quality and quantity of the faculty in the accounting group reach a level in 2023 that has led BIs top management and Senate to approve the launch of a specialization in accounting in the PhD program. The sixth SARC 2024 will coincide with the start of the first cohort of accounting PhD students at BI.

#### Achieved and potential outcomes and impacts - based on the project results

The conference attracted many high-quality researchers from Scandinavia and abroad. The keynote speaker was an editor of one of the top-three accounting journals. The doctoral colloquium was attended by 15 PhD students who received feedback on their proposals from faculty members. We are very pleased to report that increased visibility through the conference and investments made by BI has enabled BI to hire two professors, one associate professor, and five assistant professors the last six years. Simultaneously, this increase in the accounting research faculty has also led to the launch of a specialization in accounting in the PhD program. The sixth SARC 2024 coincided with the start of the first cohort of accounting PhD students at BI.

The Scandinavian Accounting Research Conference and Doctoral Consortium samler internasjonale og skandinaviske forskere innen regnskapsfeltet. Konferansen strekker seg over to dager og starter med et doktorgradskonsortium. Doktorgradskonsortiet er dedikert til å fremme den akademiske veksten til PhD-kandidater og forskere i tidlige karrierefaser ved å tilby grundig tilbakemelding på deres forskningsforslag. Hovedkonferansen inneholder seks innsiktsfulle presentasjoner ledsaget av diskusjoner ledet av anerkjente internasjonale og skandinaviske akademikere. Konferansen har som mål å fremme et kollegialt og innbydende miljø, og oppmuntre til livlige diskusjoner og meningsfulle forbindelser blant deltakerne.

Konferansen som ble holdt i august 2024 viste presentasjoner fra akademikere tilknyttet HEC Paris, London Business School, Rotman School of Management, ESSEC Business School, BI Norwegian Business School og Erasmus-universitetet. Disse presentasjonene ble diskutert av eksperter fra Oregon State University & BI Norwegian Business School, NHH Norwegian School of Economics, Handelshøyskolen i Stockholm, og London School of Economics.

The Doctoral Consortium is dedicated to nurturing the academic growth of PhD candidates and early-stage researchers by offering indepth feedback on their research proposals. The main conference features six insightful presentations accompanied by discussions led by esteemed international and Scandinavian scholars. The conference aims to foster a collegial and welcoming environment, encouraging lively discussions and meaningful connections among participants.

The Conference held in August 2024 showcased presentations from academics affiliated with HEC Paris, London Business School, Rotman School of Management, ESSEC Business School, BI Norwegian Business School, and Erasmus University. These presentations were discussed by experts from Oregon State University & BI Norwegian Business School, NHH Norwegian School of Economics, Stockholm School of Economics, and the London School of Economics.

Additionally, the conference featured a keynote address on "Tax Research - An Opportunity for Accounting Researchers" by Martin Jacbo, a distinguished professor from IESE Business School.

The doctoral colloquium and conference has taken place at the end of August 2024. It was a success with 60 participants of which 15 PhD students attended the doctoral colloquium.
